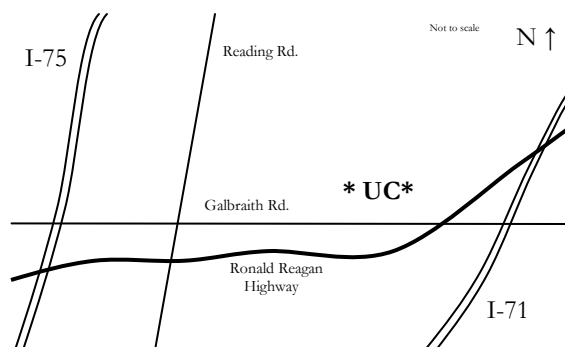

LEARNING OBJECTIVES
